

The Waterford Police Department will be participating in several 2019 National Highway Traffic Safety initiatives:

- 1) The Waterford Police Department will be participating in the “U Drive, U Text, U Pay” (April 8th-15th 2019)- National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) promoted distracted driving enforcement wave.
- 2) Every year the Governors Traffic Safety Committee supports and promotes Operation Safe Stop. Passing a stopped school bus is dangerous and puts our children at high risk when they get on or off the school bus. Thursday May 2nd, 2019 is OPERATION SAFE STOP DAY, and the Waterford Police Department will be participating in the one day enforcement effort.
- 3) The Waterford Police Department will be participating in the “No Empty Chair” Safe Teen Driver enforcement initiative during the week of April 29 –May 3rd, 2019. Officers will be focusing on different traffic safety initiatives throughout the week, to include; Speeding in School Zones, Seatbelts and Child Restraints, Cell Phone Use and Texting and Underage Drinking and Impaired Driving.
- 4) The Waterford Police Department will be participating in the upcoming (NHTSA) Click It Or Ticket, Buckle Up New York, Seat Belt Mobilization Enforcement Dates — May 20 – June 2, 2019.
