FIRST AMENDMENT TO BUILDING AND ROOFTOP LEASE AGREEMENT

This First Amendment to Building and Rooftop Lease Agreement ("First Amendment") is made and entered into the _____ day of ______, 20_____, by and between the TOWN OF WATERFORD, a municipal corporation, with its principal offices located at 65-67 Broad Street, Waterford, New York 12188 ("LESSOR") and CELLCO PARTNERSHIP d/b/a Verizon Wireless, with its principal offices at One Verizon Way, Mail Stop 4AW100, Basking Ridge, New Jersey 07920 ("LESSEE"). LESSOR and LESSEE are at times collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Parties" or individually as the "Party".

WHEREAS, LESSOR and LESSEE entered into a Building and Rooftop Lease Agreement dated March 28, 2019, (the "Agreement"), a Memorandum of which was recorded in the Saratoga County Clerk's Office on November 17, 2020 as Instrument # 2020032373; and

WHEREAS, LESSOR and LESSEE agree to modify certain terms of the Agreement as set forth in this First Amendment; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements and representations contained herein, and other good and adequate consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties amend the Premises leased under the Agreement by replacing Exhibit B of the Agreement with Exhibit B-1, attached hereto.
- 2. Following full execution of this First Amendment, LESSEE's annual rental shall increase by \$1,600.00, said increase to be effective on the next anniversary of the Commencement Date. LESSOR and LESSEE acknowledge and agree that if this First Amendment is fully executed less than 90 days before the next anniversary of the Commencement Date, the rent increase amount may not be delivered by LESSEE until at least 90 days after the full execution of this First Amendment.
- 3. This First Amendment shall be effective as of the date of full execution by both Parties.
- 4. Except as specifically set forth in this First Amendment, the Agreement is otherwise unmodified and remains in full force and effect and is hereby ratified, reaffirmed, and fully incorporated into this First Amendment. In the event of any inconsistencies between the Agreement and this First Amendment, the terms of this First Amendment shall control.
- 5. This First Amendment shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the Parties hereto.
- 6. Capitalized terms used and not otherwise defined herein shall have the same meanings as under the Agreement.

7. In the event that any one or more of the provisions contained in this First Amendment shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality or enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein, or in the Agreement shall not, in any way, be affected or impaired.


